How to Participate

- Review school profiles (coming soon) to determine potential partnership(s).
- Attend the Aug. 19th Chamber Business Expo to meet school principals.
- Commit (or recommit for existing partners) to a school to serve as an academic support partner for 2021-22 by signing an official partnership agreement.
- Conduct at least one volunteer activity or sponsorship event in 2021-22.
- Complete a partnership survey at the end of the year.

Partner Recognition

- Official partners will receive an Ascension PIE decal to display at their place of business.
- Official partners will be recognized on the district website, apsb.org.
- Official partners will be recognized on banners displayed on school campuses.
- Official partners will be invited to a district-wide recognition event.
